In 1946, Father Petrus Pavlicek made a pilgrimage to a Marian shrine in Austria. There he heard a voice within himself say:

“Do as I say and there will be peace.”

You see, after World War II, Austria was divided among the Allies with the Soviet Union awarded the richest region, including Vienna. The Austrians were subject to the atrocities of communist occupation. Naturally, they were most eager to be free again.

Father Pavlicek obeyed our Lady and founded the Holy Rosary Crusade of Reparation in 1947. The Crusade invited the faithful of Vienna to join in public square Rosary walks through city streets. They prayed for the end of Communism in Austria.

The walks began small; more like a trickle. But they grew steadily in size and frequency. They spread throughout the country and in 1955, they often had over a half-million people participating!

That was about one-tenth of the entire population of Austria. Imagine one-tenth of Americans participating in the Public Square Rosary Crusade! Miraculously, in October 1955, the Soviet forces inexplicably pulled out of Austria. The communists never before voluntarily retreated from any conquered nation. Our Lady did exactly as she promised, and she will do it for America too, **IF** we do what she asks. Like Austria, we must also bravely and devoutly publicly offer prayer and sacrifice to Our Lady, not only for us and our loved ones, but for all American. The U.S. population is over 328 million people. Imagine one-fourth (82 million) publicly praying the Rosary every day in some way.

“Pray, pray very much! Offer prayers and sacrifices constantly to the Most High.”

The Rosary is the key. There are no other options if we wish to save America. The Public Square Rosaries are essential for the conversion of our country and our return to a *one nation, under God...* without our prayers and the Rosary, our country will go the way of so many others who turned their backs on God into the dust bin of history.

1. **This year is the 104th anniversary of the miracle of the sun:** On Oct 13, 1917, Our Lady performed a miracle witnessed by over 70,000 people that included atheists, communists and anti-Catholics. Some of them converted. The 2021 Public Square Rosary Rallies will remind the person on the street that conversion is possible.
2. **Reach fallen away Catholics:** According to research, only 27% of Catholics attend Mass. The Public Square Rosary is a great way to reach the 73% of non-practicing Catholics. If they see you praying a public place, they may be moved to become better Catholics.
3. **Public prayer gets results:** Catholics have peacefully prayed the Rosary in public spaces for decades. The power of their prayer has blunted the advance of Satan and his minions. Their public prayer is reparation to God.
4. **Be a Fatima APOSTLE:** Our Lord sent the apostles forth to teach all nations. Praying the Rosary in a public place is an excellent way to introduce others to the Catholic Faith and the Fatima message.
5. **Public sins require public reparation:** Our culture openly flaunts sin on public airways, on primetime TV, on the internet. The Rosary Rally is a public act of reparation for these sins hurled against the Immaculate Heart of Mary and the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Our public Rosary will console God. At Fatima, Our Lady said to the children: *"You saw hell, where the souls of poor sinners go. To save them, God wishes to establish a devotion to my Immaculate Heart in the world."*
6. **The media will NEVER promote Fatima.** It is up to us to promote devotion to Mary. Praying the Rosary in the public square or any other public place, is a powerful way to promote its recitation. Catholics must not be ashamed of their Faith. During public Rosary rallies already held, non-Catholics have stopped and asked for Rosaries, wanting to learn how to pray.
7. **Public Rosaries in history:** At the end of World War II, Communist Soviet troops occupied Vienna, Austria. They refused to leave. Yet, after massive public Rosary processions led by Fr Petrus Pavlicek, the Communist invaders packed up and left. Large-scale public Rosaries were likewise credited for foiling a Communist takeover in Brazil in 1964. If the Rosary saved these countries, it can save the U.S.
8. **Duty to honor God publicly:** Secularists have been attempting to drive religion and morality out of the public square. For example, children in public schools have been reprimanded when they say grace before meals. We have a *duty* to oppose this secularist agenda and openly honor God and respect His rights. The Public Square Rosary Crusade makes this point.
9. **Preparing for Our Lady's triumph:** The Immaculate Heart of Mary will triumph over evil. It is a great privilege to be among those who trust in her triumph and honor her in the public square during this 104th anniversary. Imagine hundreds of Public Square Rosary Rallies all over the U.S. This historic, once-in-a-lifetime campaign will hasten God's victory, attract blessings on the U.S. and surely strengthen every rally participant.
10. **Public prayer is POWERFUL!** St. Louis de Montfort states in his monumental work, *The Secret of the Rosary*, that *Public prayer is far more powerful than private prayer to appease the anger of God and call down His mercy, and Holy Mother Church, guided by the Holy Spirit, has always advocated public prayer in times of public tragedy and suffering."*
